Parents' Evenings March 2024

We are looking forward to holding our parents' evenings in a couple of weeks. Class teachers will be holding their meetings with you on either Tuesday 26th March or Wednesday 27th March.

The focus of the consultation meetings will be to discuss your child's progress and attainment, as well as targets linked to their next steps in learning for the rest of the year. In-school Parent Consultations Arrangements:

- The main front gates will be open; please arrive on time and enter the building through the classroom door (the side and back gates will be closed as normal at 3:30pm).
- Parents/carers will be able to wait in the classroom not in use, whilst looking at your child's work.
- Please enter the school via your class drop off/pick up point apart from –
Armstrong class to go via Reception/Yr 1 gate into Sharman class
Norgay class to go into Earhart class
Darwin class to go into Attenborough class
- Please arrive on time for appointments and leave the building/site immediately afterwards.
