WP Swimming Programme – Autumn 2022

We are delighted to inform you that swimming lessons for Year 4 children will start on Monday 12th September and will continue until Monday 5th December. Swimming is an invaluable life skill and it is important for our children to feel confident in their swimming and to acquire the necessary skills.

The children will travel to Wellington Sports Centre in a coach provided by Redwoods Travel. While one class participates in swimming, the other will be supervised by school staff and concentrate on Reading/PSHE. We are grateful to the Sports Centre for providing us with this facility.

The cost of this activity is £4.70 per week which will go towards the hire of the coach, the pool and swimming instructors. **Please note, that if not enough payments are made, then swimming may not be able to take place.**

The cost for this term (11 sessions) will be £51.70 to be paid via your ParentPay account no later than **Sunday 18th September** please. This can be paid in full or in instalments. Please sign and return the permission slip attached and return before Monday 12th September.
