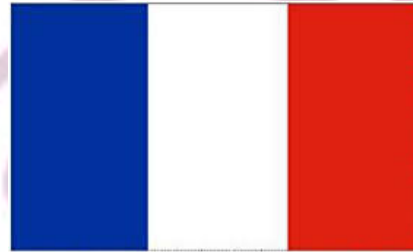

The gender of French words

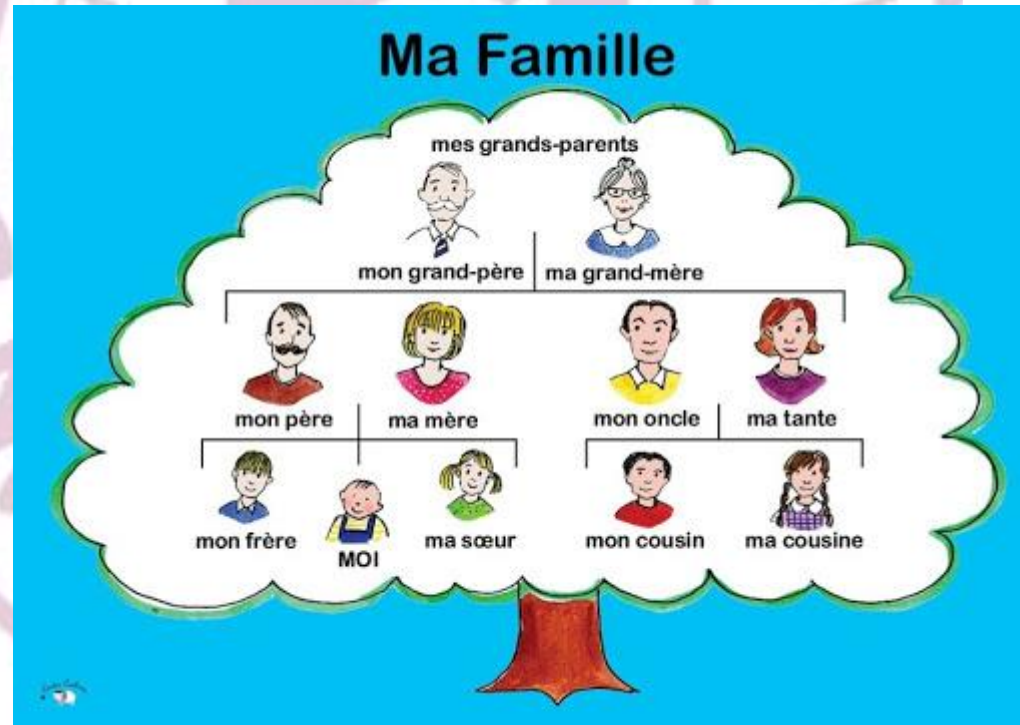
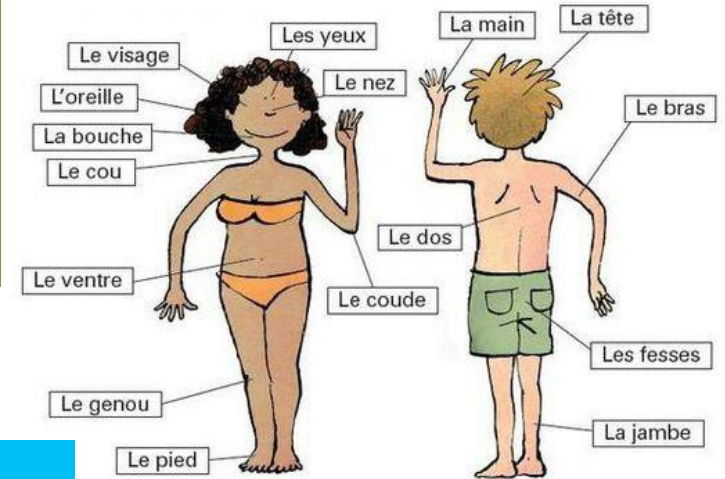
