What Should I Already Know?

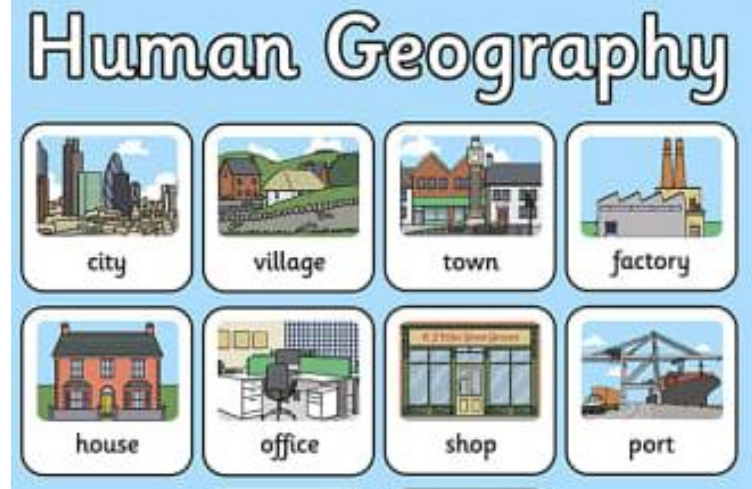
- That there are **seven continents and 5 oceans**

Geographical Skills And Fieldwork

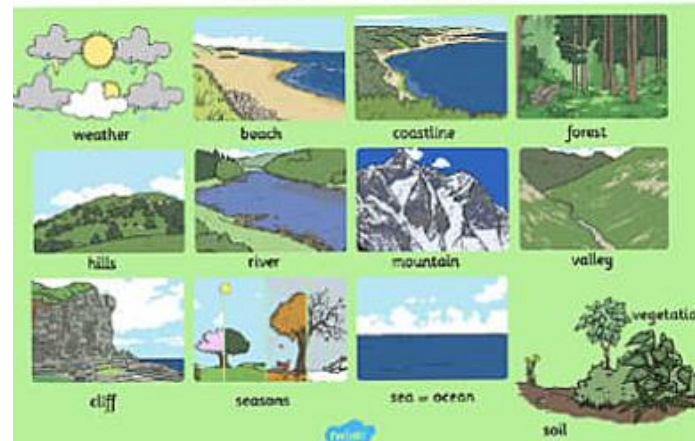
- Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key human features, including: **city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop**
- use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds and the key **human and physical features** of its surrounding environment.
- use **aerial photographs** and plan **perspectives** to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features; devise a simple **map**; and use and **construct** basic **symbols** in a key

landmark	an object or feature that can be easily recognised from a distance
map	a diagram to show land and sea
city	a large town
town	a built up area with a name
environment	the surroundings where you or animals live
human features	man made constructs
physical features	naturally occurring
photographs	a real image
aerial	an image taken from above
perspective	the angle of your view
construct	make
symbol	a simple diagram of a human or physical feature
key	explains what the symbols mean
