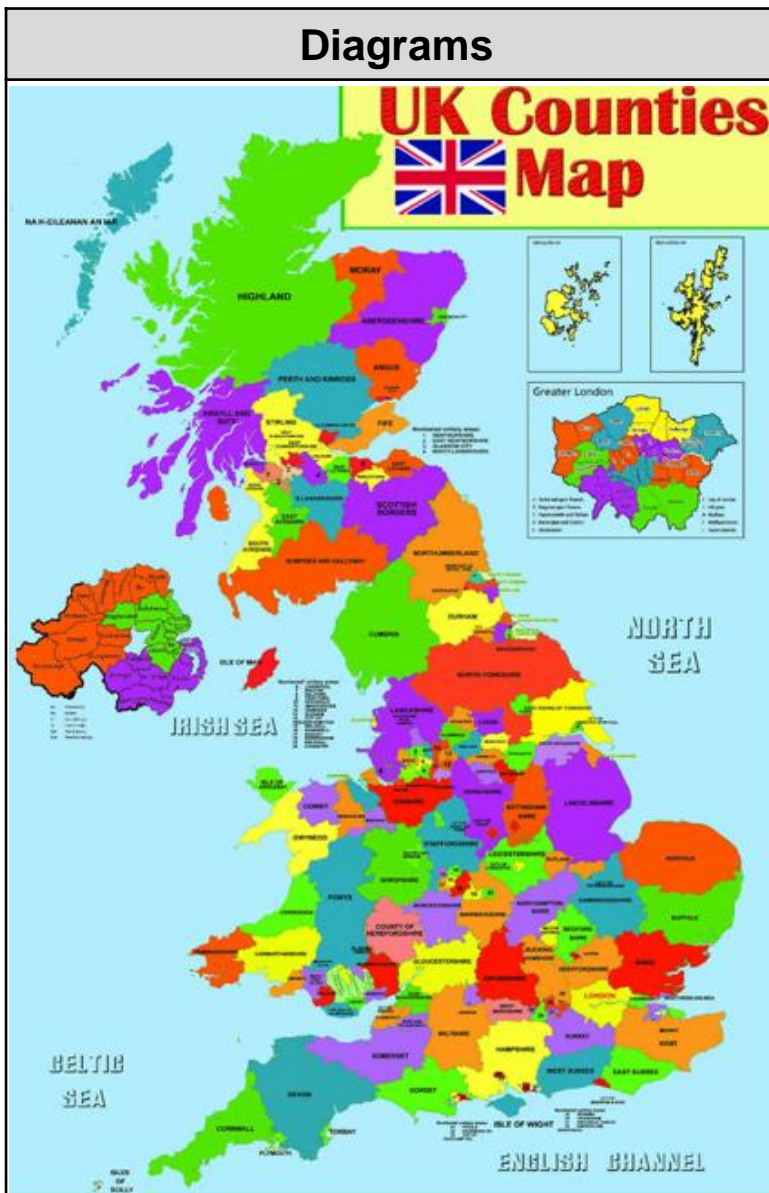

## Vocabulary

hemisphere	top or bottom half (north/south) of the globe
continent	main, continuous expanses of land
country	individually governed areas
county	divisions of land within a country
city	large urban area, often with cathedral
town	smaller than a city
village	smaller than a town
urban	town/city based
rural	in the countryside e.g. villages and farms
high ground	mountains / hills
rivers	water flowing from high ground down to the sea
lakes	areas where river water collects
