Key Vocabulary	Definition
Stop motion	Objects photographed in increments to create a short animation
Story board	A form of illustrations or images displayed in a sequence
Characters	A person in a novel, play or film
Green Screen	A green background that can provide a different scene behind the objects in front
Animation	A sequence of drawings or models to create the illusion of movement
