### School Visits – Parental consent

During your child's time at Wellesley Park, he/she will, from time to time, be taken to local places of interest in and around the Wellington area. These visits will be on foot and will be appropriately supervised by school staff. They may include visiting Court Fields School, local churches, buildings of historical interest, the Wellington Monument and other locations in conjunction with class topics. Each visit will have been risk assessed, but we do require your consent to allow your child to be taken from the school premises.

Parental consent for your child to take part in such visits will serve as generic consent, which will save you having to sign a separate slip each time your child leaves the school premises for this type of visit. Please go to Parental Consent on your Data Collection Sheet to grant this consent.

Details such as the date, time and venue will appear on the diary dates schedule, which is updated fortnightly and is sent to parents with the fortnightly newsletter. You may also receive letters giving further details of these visits including anything your child may need to take with them.
