



PARENTAL CONSENT REQUESTS

Throughout the school year, there may be occasions when parental consent is required for certain activities. In order to simplify this, we have set out below certain areas where generic parental consent can be obtained for the duration your child's time at Wellesley Park School. **Please go to Parental Consent on your Data Collection Sheet to grant this consent.** Should you have any queries, please do not hesitate to contact the office.

FOOD TASTING

Occasionally food tasting takes place in school to enhance and reinforce children's learning.

Consent is sought for your child to be involved in food tasting activities during his/her time at Wellesley Park School. If your child has an allergy/intolerance to anything, please check this appears in their medical notes BEFORE granting consent.

MEDICATION

A 'Request for School to Administer Medication' form needs to be completed and accompany any medication you wish school to administer. However, there may be occasions when your child needs a dose of Calpol during the school day.

Consent is sought for your child to be given Calpol during his/her time at Wellesley Park School. I understand that a telephone call to a member of the family will be made prior to administering.

SUN SCREEN

During the summer if it is hot, we would expect parents to apply sun screen to their child/ren before school starts in the morning. However, there may be occasions when it is necessary for sun screen to be applied by staff during the school day. The product used would be no lower than factor 30.

Consent is sought for staff to apply sun screen to your child during the day if necessary during his/her time at Wellesley Park School.
