Our curriculum

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‘Wellesley Park Explorers is the start of your child’s journey in education and will provide a solid foundation for future learning and progress.’

The preschool at Wellesley Park Explorers has dedicated rooms and outdoor space accommodated within the grounds of Wellesley Park School. It has been designed to create a stimulating, nurturing and safe environment where young children can play, make friends and grow in confidence. Your child will learn about themselves, each other and their wider world, through purposeful play activities.

Reading, writing and maths are important aspects of our preschool curriculum, tailored to meet your child’s needs.

At Wellesley Park Explorers, special attention is paid to your child’s emotional wellbeing, where each child learns about feelings and emotions through stories, circle time and imaginative play.

Each child is allocated a key worker who will be there to support your child on a more personal level – emotionally, socially, physically and academically – as well as being your point of contact with our preschool

Wellesley Park Explorers accepts children from 2 years until they commence formal schooling. Please be advised admission to Wellesley Park Explorers does not guarantee a place at Wellesley Park Primary School. The normal school admission process applies for admission to Wellesley Park Primary School. Parents/carers will still need to apply for a place in the reception year at school at the appropriate time.



Our sessions

We offer a flexible timetable to suit your needs and requirements.

We ask that all children attend sessions on at least 2 days of the week to help children feel settled and secure and to gain the most out of attending nursery. Fees are payable a month in advance. Where possible, we will try and accommodate ad hoc session requirements.

We are registered to offer free funded places via the Early Years Entitlement (EYE) hours for two, three and four year olds subject to availability and in accordance with the Somerset Code of Practice.



Admissions and Meals

Admissions

Parents/Carers are required to complete a registration form indicating the hours they wish to attend their child/ren to preschool. The nursery group manager will review the request and either confirm the requested hours, or advise as to current availability.

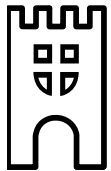
Once hours have been agreed by both parties, Wellesley Park Explorers will send out a letter of confirmation. At this stage you will be asked to complete and return the required information.

Your child will then be invited to attend Wellesley Park Explorers for their settling in session.
