What is Respect?

Respect means you have regard for the thoughts, feelings, wishes and rights of others. It is a positive feeling or action that shows a sense of admiration for the good or valuable qualities a person has.

Key Vocabulary	Definition
regard	Attention to, or concern for something
rights	Basic moral or legal need that all people are entitled to
admiration	Emotion of warm approval
qualities	An attribute or characteristic shown by somebody
