Locational Knowledge:

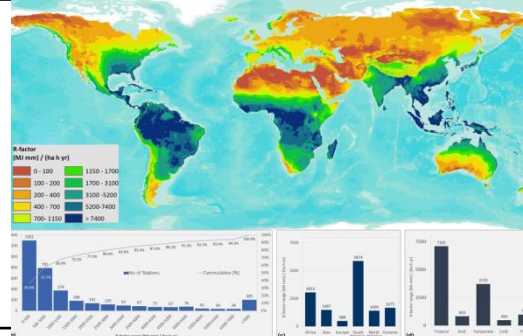
- locate the continents and countries of the world

map	a diagram to show land, sea and key features
atlas	a book of maps
globe	a spherical map of our Earth
human geography	how human activity has affected Earth
physical geography	natural features of Earth
climate	what the general weather conditions are like
weather	E.g. rain sun cloud snow frost
culture	What life is like for people
